Summer Reading Program-18 kids did at least 15 minutes per day, 9 adults registered 50 books. There were some issues with the ReadSquared program used for tracking progress.

NYS Public Library Standards- there are new minimum standards, which include annual tech training for staff

UHLIS may need to increase individual library's contributions to cover decreases in state funding. There could be dues increases of 5 or 10% rather than 2% annual increase but it would need to be approved by the directors.

Holidays- if the library is closed, staff can make up hours during that pay period.

There are 5 Federal holidays- New Year's, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Thanksgiving and Christmas

Possible other holidays are: MLK Day, President's Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day and Veteran's Day. We could be open and rotate staff so that one person doesn't have to work all the holidays.
